Passage 2

Have you ever heard of the Toy Train in India? The Toy Train, officially, the Darjeeling Himalayan Railway, is a small gauge railway connecting the cities of New Jalpaiguri and Darjeeling, an area famous for its tea. "Small gauge" means that the distance between the train tracks for the Toy Train is only 61 cm, very narrow! The train climbs up through the hills in the Indian state of West Bengal to about 2,200 meters at its terminus, its end, in Darjeeling. Starting at New Jalpaiguri, at an altitude of about 100 m, the Toy Train follows a track that includes zig zags and loops to make its way up the steep hills. Construction for the Toy Train started in 1879 and took two years to complete the 88 km length of track. In 1999, UNESCO added the train to its World Heritage Site list as one of three Mountain Railways of India.

Passage 3

New Zealand has many unique animals, which include eight living species of parrots. One of these parrots, the Kakapo, is very close to extinction, at risk of disappearing forever. The Kakapo is a large, nocturnal (it is active at night), flightless bird that lives mostly on the ground. In fact, the Kakapo is the world's heaviest parrot, with an average weight of two kilograms. It is also one of the world's longest-living birds, with some reported to have lived to 100 years. While the Kakapo doesn't use its wings to fly, it does use them for balance when it jumps from trees or rocks. Because of human activity, the Kakapo is now listed as "critically endangered." There are only about 200 of these birds alive in the world today. The New Zealand government's successful Kakapo Recovery Programme is now helping to increase the Kakapo's numbers today.
